

Dispose of a Mobile Home, Trailer Home, Camp Trailer, Camper Shell, and Modular Home

Preparation

Asbestos Inspection - Bingham County can accept manufactured (Trailer) Homes without an asbestos inspection as long as the removal is not part of a commercial development. The term commercial development would include land intended for residential development.

If the trailer home is not privately owned and lived in for that purpose the HOME will have to be inspected for asbestos by a certified asbestos inspector.

For the HOME to be accepted an inspection report shall be given to the landfill attendant

Title - The title for the trailer home will have to be signed and delivered to the landfill attendant showing the legal owner has released all interest and rights for the home.

- Remove** - Remove the following items:
- 1) All Furniture
 - 2) Refrigeration Units
 - i. Air conditioners that contain Freon
 - ii. Refrigerators
 - iii. Deep Freezers
 - 3) Carpeting and pad
 - 4) Florescent lights (tubes and ballasts)
 - 5) Thermostats

Prior Arrangements - Arrangements must be made at least one week in advance with the facility that you choose to take your trailer home to.

Transportation of TRAILER HOME

Towing:

- 1) Make sure the Trailer Home is legal and worthy of being pulled on the road
- 2) The truck and or trailer is licensed to tow the Home
- 3) Pulled during daylight hours
- 4) Pilot vehicles are used

Hauled:

- 1) Some Trailer Homes are not road worthy and need to be hauled

- 2) Make certain the trailer and pieces of the trailer are secured
- 3) HOME does not need to be licensed if hauled
- 4) Some recycling companies have equipment to be able to load and haul HOMES

Choices of Disposal Location

Aberdeen

- Can accept small pickup campers and small pull trailers.
- Larger trailers, single-wide's etc., need to be taken to one of the other sited.

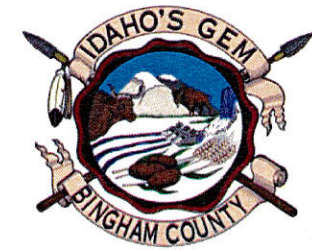
Rattlesnake:
